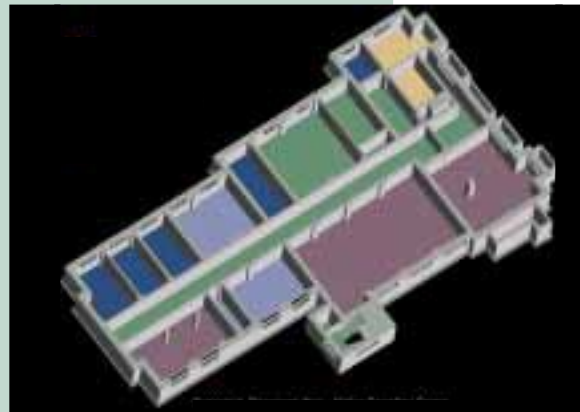
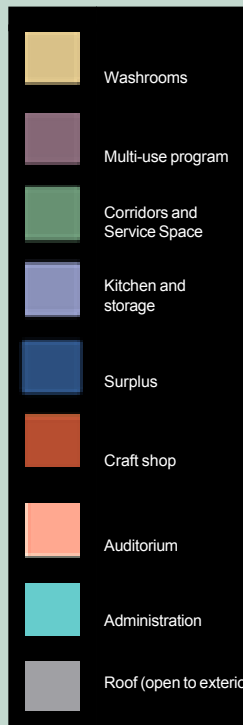
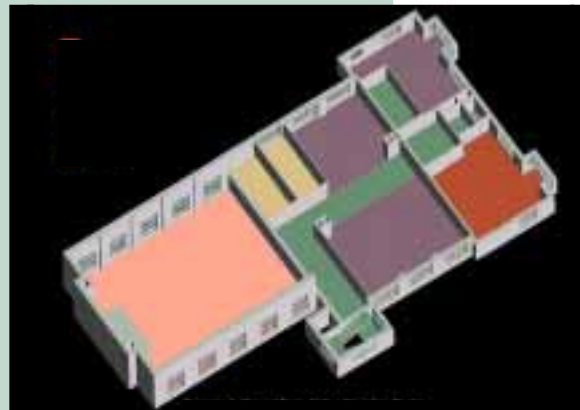


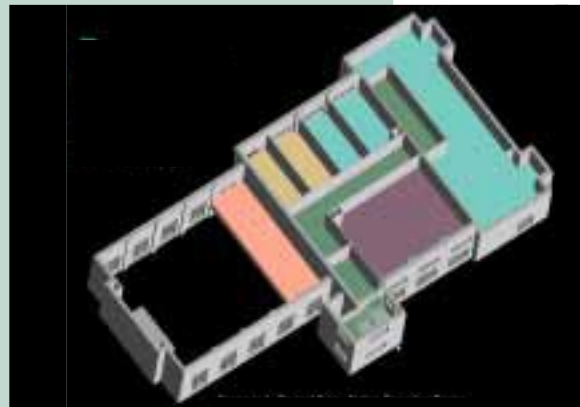
Feasibility Study for the Native Canadian Centre of Toronto



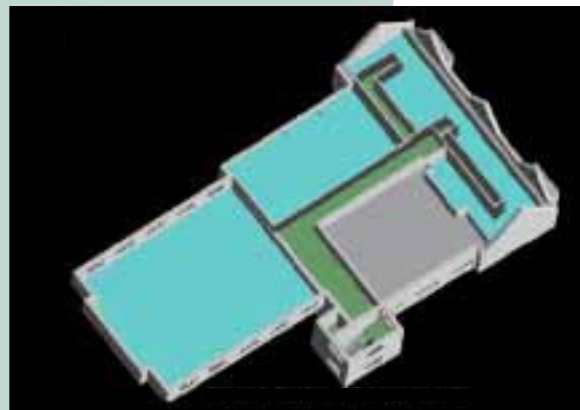
Basement Floor
