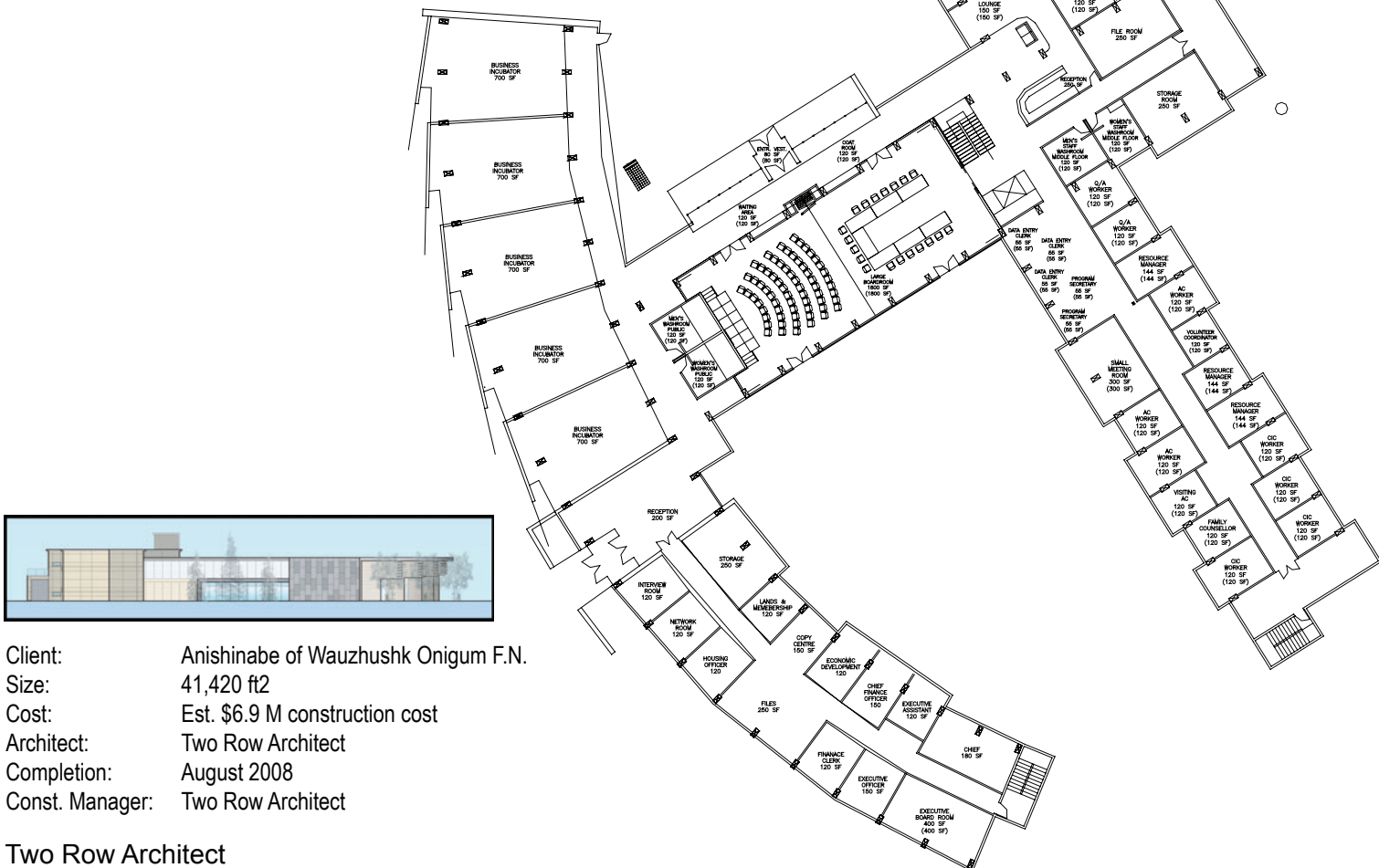


Anishinabe of Wauzhushk Onigum - Business & Admin. Complex



The First Nation proposed this administration building to accommodate their administration offices, along with two anchor tenants to contribute to the operational overhead. The additional insertion of 5 business incubator suites serve to stimulate and promote local private sector development as well. This innovative, two storey, multi-purpose facility is designed to amalgamate two essential zones. The first zone has been designed to allow for after hours use of the multi-purpose room with access to the vestibule and barrier free washroom only at the discretion of the administration. The second zone is comprised of the staff offices, service areas, the filing room, mechanical and maintenance rooms. The southern exposure of the building enables the utilization of natural light and passive solar heating.
